Her stories have appeared in anthologies including *Detroit Noir, Queens Noir* and the *Best American Mystery Stories of 2014*. She is also the author of *The Street Was Mine*, a study of hardboiled fiction and film noir. She has taught at NYU and the New School University and was the John Grisham Writer-in-Residence at the University of Mississippi. Her next novel, *You Will Know Me*, comes out in July 2016.

She is the founding president of the Women's National Book Association of New Orleans, a former member of the boards of the New Orleans Public Library and the Tennessee Williams/New Orleans Literary Festival, as well as a two-time chair of the jury for the Pulitzer Prize for Fiction. She served as the book review editor for The New Orleans Times-Picayune for 22 years.



Bill Loefhelm is the author of the Maureen Coughlin/NOLA crime fiction series from Sarah Crichton Books/FSG. The third installment, *Doing the Devil's Work*, was published in January 2015. Bill's other novels include *The Devil She Knows* (2011), Maureen's debut, and the second Maureen Coughlin novel, *The Devin in Her Way*, *Strand* Magazine's 2013 Novel of the Year.
